However, we were able to go back to a few fundraisers such as the Coborn's Brat Sales and the Pizza Ranch Community Impact Night. We will continue with these fundraisers in 2022. We also added a new fundraiser event with the Sweethearts Dinner at home (working with Coborn's) and we moved our Bean Bag Tournament to the Morrison County Fair. We hope to add a new fundraiser later in 2022. More to come!

Our 2021 business blitz in September kicked off our 2021 campaign which ended in December. We are so grateful for the community support - our campaign finished up YOY from the 2020 campaign and was in line with 2019. Other non-profits have experienced this same trend. Luckily we were able to pick up a few other ways to earn income when fundraising was impacted by the inability to have inperson fundraisers. We are also excited to announce that we will be receiving \$14,000 of Congressionally Directed Spending thanks to Senator Tina Smith who worked to get us this funding for our Imagination Library program. These dollars will not only impact the Imagination Library program but will impact all of our work and all of the communities we serve. We are so grateful for this funding! This funding will cover nearly half of our Imagination Library budget for 2022!

# **OUR PROGRAMS, YOUR IMPACT**

Tools for School is one of our signature programs. Here's a look at the program:

- School supplies are provided to 5 area schools: Lindbergh and Lincoln Elementary in Little Falls, Dr. SG Knight in Randall, Royalton Elementary, and Swanville Schools.
- This program started in 2017 and has since impacted over 300 area learners and over 30 teachers. For the 2021-2022 school year over 3,000 supplies were delivered with a focus on making the year easier for teachers and students which included much needed headphones for all 5 schools!

Thanks to a grant from Morrison County Area Foundation we were able to focus on the much needed headphones. A **BIC** thank you to the businesses in Swanville for taking on the funding needs for the Swanville Schools. They are making this program possible for that area!
